Ontario government launches Regional Development Program: Advanced Manufacturing and Innovation Competitiveness Stream

In February 2022, the Ontario government has launched the [Advanced Manufacturing and Innovation Competitiveness \(AMIC\) program](#) to help companies get the tools, technology, and talent they need to grow, compete and innovate in an increasingly competitive global market.

This AMIC Stream of the Regional Development Program will provide financial support to advanced manufacturing companies focusing on small and medium-sized enterprises (SME) across Ontario. By way of investments in capital equipment, technology adoption, and skills development, this program will accelerate recovery in Ontario and place companies in competitive global positions.

There are two periods where applications to this program will be accepted. The first window to submit applications is from **January 17, 2022 - February 10, 2022**. It is strongly encouraged that an eligibility checklist be submitted by **February 1, 2022**, so you will have enough time to complete your full application, if you are eligible to apply. The second window to submit applications will be added later in 2022.
